How to Apply (link)

Click **Apply Now!** to initiate the online application. You will be prompted to create your own username and password. (**Remember to save your username and password to return and complete/edit the application at any time.*)

- Once logged in, please complete the online application form. Note that a separate application must be completed for each child applying to Ashbury College. If you are an Agent or Consultant, please ensure that you complete the **Consultant** portion of the online application.
- A \$150.00 fee is required to submit the online application. After reviewing the application, you will be prompted to pay by credit card prior to submitting. If you have trouble with your credit card payment, please contact a member of the [Admissions Team](#) who will provide you with a waiver code and an alternate method of payment.

Admissions Process

The following file types may be uploaded to your child's online application: PDF, JPEG, Word

- Photograph: Upload a recent photo of the applicant
- Personal Profile: A 300-word letter of introduction, written by the applicant providing the following details: academic interests and achievements, extracurricular activities, areas of distinction, and community involvement. Candidates applying to Grades 7 to 11 are to write their personal profile themselves. Parents may help prepare the profile for candidates applying to Grades 4, 5 and 6. Once complete, upload the file to the online application.
- Upload 2019–20 Final Report Card
- Upload 2020–21 Report Cards as they become available
- Confidential Reference: Please click 'Add' to enter the email of the applicant's Math or English teacher, or school Principal, then 'Submit'. This will send our fillable PDF document directly to the recipient to complete and submit to Admissions.
- Entrance Exam: All applicants are required to complete an entrance exam for admission to Ashbury College. This year, our entrance exam will be available remotely. Entrance Exam dates will be posted on the Admissions home page on

our website. Students applying from a distance may write our entrance exam or the SSAT at a certified test center.

- Day Visit: At this time, we are unable to host any students on campus.
- External Assessments and Educational Support: If applicable, please upload any Psychological Education Assessment or Individual Educational Plan.
- Financial Assistance: Financial assistance is available to families who qualify by completing the Apple Financial assessment. If you wish to apply for financial assistance, please indicate this on the Ashbury application form and then complete the online Apple Financial application found here:

Receive Admissions Decision

- There are two rounds of admission to Ashbury College's Day Program with offers being extended in mid-December and mid-March. We encourage all families to apply in early October as 85% of all awards and bursary dollars are allocated with the December offers.
- Boarding Program offers are extended year-round provided there is a place available in our residence. Boarding intake Grades are 9, 10 and 11. We encourage all boarding students to apply early, as traditionally our boarding program is fully enrolled by mid-April.
