<b>7</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>96 to 100%</b>
<b>6</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>90 to 95%</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>80 to 89%</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>70 to 79%</b>
<b>3</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>60 to 69%</b>
<b>2</b>	<b>=</b>	<b>50 to 59%</b>
