Standards and Expectations for Ashbury Students

In addition to living the Ashbury Mission, Core Values and School Motto, students are expected to conduct themselves in an exemplary fashion.

All students are responsible for being acquainted with school regulations including the following, found in the *Senior School Handbook*:

- Prohibited Activities
- Positive Social Behavior And Dealing With Conflict And Bullying
- Ashbury Technology Acceptable Use Policies
- Consequences Of Inappropriate Behavior

With the increasing presence of technology at the school as a teaching, learning and communication tool it is important that the students follow some basic guidelines to further maintain an academic and respectful school environment:

Technology Use Guidelines

- Expectations of student conduct extend equally to all aspects of technological use including social media.
- The focus of technology use during the academic day is on academics.
- Gaming is not permitted during the academic day.

- Student use of and access to cellphones and laptops in the classroom is at the discretion of the classroom teacher.
- Students are not permitted to wear earphones or use cellphones when moving around the school. The use of these devices is permitted when seated in the various public areas, and in classrooms with the permission of the classroom teacher.

Substance Use and Abuse Policies (in student handbook)

- Use or possession of drugs, alcohol or tobacco is not acceptable at Ashbury College, within the vicinity of the school and on school sponsored trips.

School Uniform and Standards

- Students are responsible for keeping their uniform clean, tidy, in good repair, and to ensure that the uniform is worn appropriately.

Food and Drink

- Students are not permitted to consume food or drink in classrooms, corridors, or in other public areas, outside Maclaren Hall, unless sanctioned by a member of staff for a specific occasion (e.g. TAG snack or club lunch). Students are permitted to carry and consume water throughout the school.
