Ashbury College is a leading not-for-profit independent day and boarding school for students in Grades 4 to 12 located in Canada's capital and the traditional, unceded territory of the Anishinàbe Algonquin Nation. We serve a diverse community of over 60 nationalities from around the National Capital Region, the diplomatic community and international and domestic boarding students.

Our mission is to inspire students in a dynamic learning environment as intellectually curious, compassionate and responsible global citizens. Our strategic direction is centered on the highest standards in teaching and learning; whole student development; access and inclusion in our pluralistic community; community engagement; and resource stewardship for long term-sustainability.

Ashbury College is currently seeking Senior School Teachers to lead each of our Heather Gillin and Matthews Boarding programs. Each position could also include up to 3 classes in appropriate disciplines subject to availability.

In your capacity as Head of House – Boarding, you'll be responsible to ensure the social, emotional, and academic wellbeing of 50+ boarding students. Leading 3 residential staff, you will schedule and participate in the provision of rotational boarding supervision and pastoral care; plan schedule and occasionally run weekend programs; respond to students' issues; orient new boarding students; and communicate with their parents. You will work closely with the Boarding program team led by the Assistant Head of Senior School & consisting of Heads of House – Boarding Gillin and Matthews, Assistant Heads of House - Boarding Gillin, Matthews, and Maple Residences, and 6 other Boarding staff to provide an inclusive, supportive, and creative Boarding life culture and programs.

As you will need to be available and provide ongoing support to boarding students, you are expected to reside in large, self-contained on-campus housing accessible to the Gillin or Matthews residence. While your housing will be provided year round, board is included for the course of the academic year.

You are also an experienced senior school teacher, whose own professional growth has been reflected by subject matter expertise, innovation, and the creative use of technology in the classroom.

Experience leading boarding or congregate living programs plus prior teaching experience, and eligibility for Ontario College of Teachers Certification is required, as is a history of adding to the full life of the school. Training, skills and/or lived experience related to diversity, equity and inclusion are assets, as is fluency in additional languages. We strongly encourage applications from all qualified individuals who are members of groups with historical and/or current barriers to equity.

If you are as passionate about guiding and supporting youth as you are committed to encouraging curiosity and instilling an enthusiasm for learning in senior grade students, we want to hear from you.
