



Admissions Application Process

Welcome to Admissions at Ashbury College. Throughout the year, our team is available to speak to you about Ashbury College. Please contact a member of our team to set up a school visit. How to Apply

Click the **Apply!** button to begin the online application. You will be prompted to create an account with your own username and password. Remember to save your username and password so that you can return and complete/edit the online application.

- Once logged in, please complete the online application form. Note that a separate application must be completed for each applicant applying to Ashbury College. If you are an Agent or Consultant, please ensure that you complete the Consultant section of the online application.
- A \$200.00 payment is required to submit the application. You will be prompted to pay by credit card prior to submitting. Contact a member of the Admissions Team if you experience credit card issues; a waiver code will be provided so you are able to submit the application.

Admissions Process

The following file types may be uploaded to your child's online application: PDF, JPEG, Word

- Photograph: Upload a recent photo of the applicant
- Personal Profile: A 300-word letter of introduction, as described in the link found in MySchoolApp. Candidates applying to Grades 7-12 are to write their own personal profile. Parents may support candidates applying to Grades 4, 5 and 6. The completed personal profile is uploaded to the online application.
- Upload 2021-2022 final report card
- Upload 2022-2023 report cards as they become available
- Confidential Reference: Please click "Add" to enter the email of the applicant's Math or English teacher, or school Principal, then submit. Our fillable PDF will be sent directly to the recipient to complete and submit to Admissions.

- Entrance Exam: All applicants are required to complete an entrance exam for admission to Ashbury College. The entrance exam is available online and test dates are posted on the Ashbury website. Students applying from a distance may write the Ashbury exam or the SSAT, at a certified test center.
- Day Visits: We are happy to host your child for a day at Ashbury College. Please [book](#) online.
- Educational Assessment and Educational Support: If applicable, please upload any Psychological Educational Assessment or Individual Education Plan.
- Financial Assistance: Financial Assistance is available to families who qualify by completing the Apple Financial Assessment. If you wish to apply for financial assistance, please indicate this on the online application form and complete the online [Apple Financial Application](#) form. Ashbury College will cover the cost of the first assessment. Please contact a member of our Admissions Team for the waiver code.

Admissions Decisions

- There are two rounds of admission to Ashbury College's Day Program with offers extended in mid-December and mid-March. We encourage all families to apply in early October as 85% of all awards and bursary dollars are allocated to December offers.
- Boarding Program offers are extended year-round provided there is a place available in our residences. Boarding intake grades are 9, 10 and 11. We encourage all boarding students to apply early, as traditionally our boarding program is fully enrolled by mid-April.
