All international boarding students must have a legal guardian while attending school in Canada. The legal guardian is the local contact for your child's school.

### **Professional Guardianship Services**


It is very important to have a responsible and attentive guardian for your child to have a successful experience in Canada. CAS staff is always available to offer support for our students throughout their school year.

Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) requires all applicants under the age of 18 who are applying for an initial Canadian Study Permit or renewal to provide a Notarized Custodianship Declaration as part of their Student Permit and Visa application. The guardian remains on file with the Canadian Government as your child's local representative. This original document must be completed and notarized by the Guardian/ Custodian as well as natural parents.

5. Permissions forms & Leave approval
6. Attendance at Graduation in June
